

raised as of 12/31 towards our 75th Anniversary Campaign goal of \$17,000,000.


Over \$1,100,000

Classroom Transformation:

Already, we have transformed nine classrooms on the first floor into Active Learning Centers based on the model at Columbia University and into a STEAM Center. This makes our students globally competitive at the graduate and undergraduate level.
