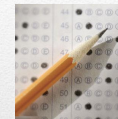

- **SAT/ACT**
  - Recommendations
  - Testing dates (see handouts)
- **Test-Optional Schools**  
[www.Fairtest.org](http://www.Fairtest.org)  
2000 + schools
- We strongly encourage the students to take a practice tests for **both** the SAT and the ACT to determine which test works best for them
- Whenever possible, we advise students to complete their testing before the beginning of their Senior year

# ACT Superscoring

## Deadlines MUST be adhered to !

- Early Action : Early Nov.
- Early Decision : Early Nov.
- Regular Decision : Jan. - Feb.
- Rolling Admission : Until Filled

\*Student must apply in advance of the actual college deadline (2-3 weeks) to allow everything to be received by the college in time.

## Reach-Match-Safety

Students apply to approximately 6-10 schools

- Two or so '**Reach**' schools, where the admission criteria exceed the student's credentials
- Two or so '**Match**' schools where the admissions criteria resemble the student's credentials
- Two or so '**Safety**' schools, where the admissions criteria are lower than the student's credentials

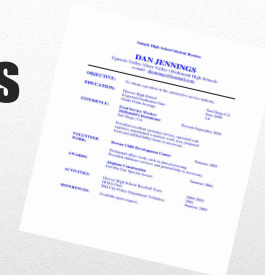
The 'safety' school should be one the student would attend if admitted.

## Resumes/ Essays

**Resume** - students should have initial document completed

**The Essay** - rough draft started in spring

Juniors will begin drafts of their college essay writing for the Spring.





#### What is it?

- A standardized application to be used instead of an individual school application

#### Who uses it?

- Approximately 1100 Colleges and Universities with more every year
- Many schools require supplemental information

#### When?

- Start in class in late Spring

#### Why use it?

- More efficient, easier, neater, saves time, aligns with Naviance for electronic document submission.

## Student & Family Responsibilities

1. Register for the SAT/ACT
  2. Resume (initial one already complete)
  3. College Visits
  4. Essay and Supplemental Essays
  5. Request teacher letters of recommendation
  - 6. Submission of Common Application and Fee**
  7. Transcript request
  8. NCAA Registration
  - 9. Sending Standardized Test Scores**
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## Stepinac is Responsible for:

1. Educate and advise students and their families on the college process
  2. Prepare various school documents
  3. Counselor Report
  4. Counselor recommendation letter
  5. Send official transcripts
  6. School Profile
  7. Process all other supporting documents
  8. Review students' entire application before submission
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## Checklist: Spring Semester 2026

- Register for SAT and ACT
  - Sign up for test prep
  - Generate a list of prospective colleges (should have 10-15 already)
  - Meet with your counselor
  - Research colleges
  - Look at admissions requirements for each school
  - Begin college visits
  - Request teacher recommendations
  - Plan for the summer: job, internship, enrichment, etc.
  - Plan a strong senior schedule
  - Get the best grades you can!
